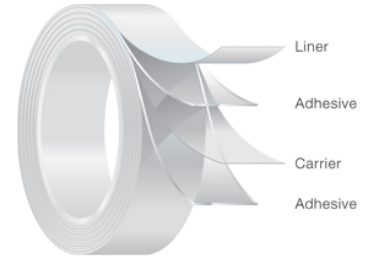

This product offers a high initial tack, allowing for adhesion to various natural and synthetic substrates. This product also contains a heavyweight liner with ideal release for kiss cutting, die-cutting, and converting.
